of Nantes : An edict signed in by King Henry IV of France that granted the Calvinist Protestants of France also known as Huguenots substantial rights in the nation, which was, at the time, still considered essentially Catholic. He functioned essentially as the co-ruler of France alongside Queen Anne during her regency, and until his death effectively directed French policy alongside the monarch.
